I invite you to apply for membership of the Church's Electoral Roll on the form opposite. This is relevant both to those who were already on the Roll last year, and also to those who are not currently on the Roll, which is fully revised from scratch every six years. A single Roll is maintained for the whole Parish, though in separate sections for the two Parish Churches.

When you enrol, you are identifying yourself as a member of the Church at Wargrave or Knowl Hill/Warren Row. This implies accepting a responsibility in corporate worship, prayer, service, fellowship, financial support and sharing the Gospel, so that the Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified. As explained on the form, membership is not confined to members of the Church of England. Naturally, all are welcome to share in the life and worship of their local Church without necessarily joining the Electoral Roll.

- 2C I am a member in good standing of a Church (not in communion with the Church of England) which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity and also declare myself to be a member of the Church of England and I have habitually attended public worship in the parish during the period of six months prior to enrolment.

I declare that the above answers are true and I apply for inclusion on the Church Electoral Roll of the Parish of Wargrave with Knowl Hill, and for the PCC of the Parish to hold and process my personal data according to its Privacy Policy.

Notes

1. Those who become 16 during the next 12 months may complete the form, and become eligible to be entered on the Roll on their sixteenth birthday.
2. On this form 'Parish' means an ecclesiastical parish.
3. The only Churches at present in communion with the Church of England are other Anglican Churches and certain foreign Churches.
4. Membership of the Electoral Roll is also open to members in good standing of a Church not in communion with the Church of England which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity where those members are also prepared to declare themselves to be members of the Church of England.
5. Every 6 years a new Roll is prepared and those on the previous Roll are informed so that they can re-apply. If you are not resident in the parish but were on the Roll as an habitual worshipper and have been prevented by sickness or absence or other essential reason from worshipping for the past six months, you may write 'would' before 'have habitually attended' on the form and add 'but was prevented from doing so because' and then state the reason.
6. If you have any problems over completing this form, please approach the Vicar, or Richard Lloyd (the Electoral Roll Officer of the PCC), who will be pleased to help you.
